Handling of Order, Payment and Delivery

1. The Applicant sends his request to the Director of the WFNS Central Office. The request should include the Sponsor and Consignee's addresses.
2. The WFNS supplies the Applicant with a questionnaire which must be completed and returned to the Director of the WFNS. The President of WFNS, the Second Vice-Presidents or in some cases, the President of the Applicant's national society, determine whether or not the request is justified.
3. If the Applicant's request is approved, the Director of WFNS forwards the order in the name of the Sponsor together with the address of the Applicant to Carl Zeiss.
4. An order confirmation is provided to the WFNS and a copy is provided to the Sponsor, the Applicant and to the local Carl Zeiss representative.
5. Delivery is made to the Consignee on a CIP basis. Carl Zeiss contacts the local Carl Zeiss representative to arrange for delivery, installation and in-service with the Applicant.
6. Carl Zeiss sends an invoice to the WFNS.
7. The WFNS transfers the total amount of money to Carl Zeiss.
